INFORMATION ABOUT POLAND

A unitary state in Central
Europe, located between the
Baltic Sea in the north and the
Sudetes and Carpathians in the
South, mostly in the basin of
the Vistula and Odra



WARSZAWA/WARSAW

- From 1596, the capital of Poland is Warsaw, it is located in the Masovian Voivodeship, it is also the largest city.
- The Vistula flows through Warsaw, which makes it the longest river in Poland. The length of the Vistula is 1047 km.







- Łódź is in the center of Poland and is the third largest city.
- The city's coat of arms depicts a boat
 (łódź in Polish), which alludes to the city's
 name. The village in the fourteenth
 century belonged to a bishop whose coat
 of arms depicted a boat.



In Łódź there are 5 different districts: Bałuty, Polesie, Widzew, Śródmieście and Górna.

There are 700 000 residents.



CITY HISTORY

 Łódź was once a small settlement that first appeared in 14th-century records. It was granted town rights in 1423.


PIOTRKOWSKA STREET

The most notable and recognizable landmark of the city is Piotrkowska Street, which remains the high-street and main tourist attraction in the city, runs north to south for a little over five kilometres (3.1 miles). This makes it one of the longest commercial streets in the world. Most of the building façades, many of which date back to the 19th century, have been renovated. It is the site of most restaurants, bars and cafes in Łódź's city centre.



PALACES

 Compared to other Polish cities, Lodz stands out with a great number of palaces and villas. There are more than 200 such objects. All of them were built in the 19th or early 20th century and almost all belonged to owners of factories. Former palaces serve today as seats of offices, institutions and museums.



HERBST PALACE AND MUSEUM

 This large mansion is situated next to a lovely little lake. It was built by the city's biggest industrial families, the Scheiblers and the Herbsts, in the 19th century. It can be found adjacent to the industrial settlement Księży Młyn, which was a housing complex for the people working for the Scheibler family in their spinning and weaving mills. You can still visit this fascinating area.



POZNAŃSKI PALACE

• The palace of Izrael Poznański is the largest industrialist's residence in

Poland.




MANUFAKTURA

If you enjoy both shopping and history you should definitely come to Manufaktura. The shopping center is located in the beautiful brick buildings of the former 19th-century industrial estate that belonged to the textile magnate Izrael Poznanski and is well worth a tour. There are 240 shops and boutiques to browse through as well as many restaurants, a cinema, pubs, hairdressers, theaters, a fitness center, a bowling alley, a laser game center, and an interactive museum of science and technology. The Museum of the Factory can also be found here, which details the history of the former industrial estate and the textile industry in general and is fun for all ages.



MUSEUM OF MODERN ART

 Łódź's Musuem of Modern Art is one of the oldest museums of Modern Art in the world and owns one of the most interesting and richest collections of the 20th and 21st century art in Europe.



ŁAGIEWNICKI FOREST

• One of the biggest municipal forests in Europe. It covers an area of about 1,200 ha (2,965 ac). It is a remnant of former Lodz Primeval Forest which existed in the present Lodz and its surroundings until 200 years ago. The most valuable part of the forest is protected as a natural reserve. In the forest, there are two wooden baroque chapels. The latter one is the oldest building of Lodz. Inside the chapel, there is a well providing spring water, which is considered to be miraculous.




LIGHT MOVE FESTIVAL

Our school is located in the center of Łódź-Śródmieście, on Rewolucji 1905r. street.

















