Explore Mont Blanc

Aims:

- to increase students knowledge of subject content;
- to develop academic skills such as note taking;
- to help students to understand the importance of exploring;
- to activate students exciting knowledge of the topic;
- to identify what they would like to learn about the topic.

Introduction

- 1. Begin the discussion the concept of mountains and their significance in geography.
- 2. Introduce Mount Mont Blanc as the highest mountain in the European Union and one of the iconic peaks in the Alps.

Activity 1

1. Show students a map and guide them in location Mont Blanc.

2. Have students mark the location on their own maps.

 Discuss the neighbouring countries and regions around Mount Mont Blanc.

2. Engage students in a group discussion (the questions are after video) about the most interesting places in Chamonix.
