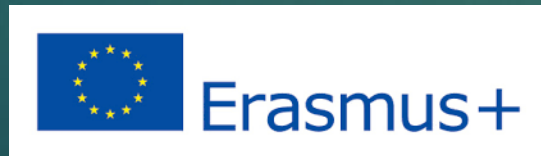

- ▶ Web 2.0 concept was first used in 2004 by O'Reilly and MediaLive. It emerged while discussing the developments in the Web field and the future of the Web world at the Web conference organized by International and attended by the leading companies of the Web world such as Google, Yahoo, Msn, Amazon, Ebay.

- ▶ Kaplan and Haenlein (2010) , define the concept of Web 2.0; defined as a platform where content and applications are no longer created and published by the individual, but are continually modified by all users in a participatory and collaborative manner.

- ▶ Web 2.0 applications, which have the feature of providing access to constantly developing and changing information according to the needs of the users and facilitating the interaction between the users, are free, easy to use and diverse. The first examples that come to mind when Web 2.0 is mentioned are Facebook, Wikipedia, WhatsApp, Instagram and Twitter.




Contribution of Web 2.0 Technology to Education and Foreign Language Education


- ▶ Virtual learning environments with the transfer of information sharing to the digital environment enriched and increased the diversity of educational technology.
