Point 1: A statue of the Croatian writer August Cesarec – "The Walker"



A true story: during the war there was an alert and one lady ran to the shelter. She saw the statue and she thought it was a man. She ran to it and tried to "take" it to the shelter.

Look at "The Walker's" foot. The legend says that you will come back to Osijek if you touch its foot.

Point 2: Monument to Croatian War Veterans - The Door of the Europe



The statue was constructed by means of iron blocks which show how the town opens itself to Europe. The iron blocks were supposed to rust which symbolizes the suffering of the people during the war.
